

## **Application Deadline: March 1**

The Louisville Tango Festival Scholarship is available to full-time and part-time Latino/a/x and Hispanic students pursuing a degree in any major at the University of Louisville. Undergraduate and graduate students may apply. Preference will be given to students who have been active in Latino & Hispanic arts or community groups. The recipient will be notified by May 1. The \$1,000 award will be presented to the recipient at the Louisville Tango Festival's Saturday Showcase on Saturday, June 8, 2019, and includes two passes for the recipient and a guest.

The Scholarship Recipient will be selected from applicants that are:

- 1. Current, full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate students at the University of Louisville who have completed at least one semester.
- 2. Students that identify as Latino or Hispanic.
- 3. Students that have a 2.75 or higher cumulative Grade Point Average.

All applicants must complete the provided application which includes: a personal resume, a one page personal statement, an unofficial transcript, and one letter of recommendation from an educational or community professional.

The Completed Application must include the following:

- 1. Application (available at <a href="http://www.louisvilletangofestival.com/scholarship.html">http://www.louisvilletangofestival.com/scholarship.html</a>)
- 2. Resume (include information about any involvement in Latino & Hispanic arts or community groups)
- 3. Personal statement (maximum length 1 page) introducing yourself to the selection committee while addressing your career goals and how the LTF Scholarship would assist you in pursuit of your degree
- 4. Unofficial copy of most recent college transcript (http://louisville.edu/registrar/online-services)
- 5. One letter of recommendation from education or community professional knowledgeable of applicants' academic and/or volunteer performance. Letters from relatives will not be accepted.
- 6. An agreement to attend the June 8, 2019, Louisville Tango Festival Showcase, held at the Seelbach Hilton, to receive the scholarship. The presentation will be made at approximately 10:30pm.
